Contracto Marian Anderson is considered one of the most important singers of the 20th century. Known for her impressive three-octave vocal range, she performed widely in the U.S. and Europe, beginning in the 1920s. In 1936, she was invited to perform at the White House for President Franklin Roosevelt and first lady Eleanor Roosevelt, the first African-American so honored. Three years later, after the Daughters of the American Revolution refused to allow Anderson to sing at a Washington D.C. gathering, the Roosevelts invited her to perform on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial.

Anderson continued to sing professionally until the 1960s when she became involved in politics and civil rights issues. Among her many honors, Anderson received the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 1963 and a Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award in 1991.
